CATS ACADEMY BOSTON PROFILE 2021–2022

CATS Academy Boston offers an American college-preparatory curriculum to a predominantly international student body in grades 9–12 who are linguistically, culturally, and academically diverse. For the 2021-2022 school year there are 305 boarding and day students including 27 freshman, 50 sophomores, and 108 juniors.

There are 115 seniors and 3 Post-Graduate students in the Class of 2021.

Due to COVID-19, during the 2020–2021 year we were a hybrid school with both an in-person cohort and an online cohort.

THE AMERICAN HOCKEY ACADEMY

CATS Academy Boston is proud to establish our unique hockey program this year. Our hockey academy fields U16 and U18 teams that compete locally and nationally representing CATS Academy Boston. Led by former NHL and college coaches, our team competes from late August through March. Students attend academic classes during the morning and practice each afternoon.

THE ACADEMIC PROGRAM

For the current school year, CATS Boston provides college-preparatory core courses, a range of electives, 15 AP courses, and 13 Honors courses.

Seniors are limited to four AP classes and juniors to three AP classes, with rare exceptions. Each year, students enroll in at least five core courses plus elective(s) based on individual learning recommendations. Progress through the levels of standard college-prep to Honors, to AP, to Independent Study is based on departmental faculty recommendations. Multivariable Calculus students are expected to take the AP Calculus BC exam.

Due to budget and staff constraints during the 2020–2021 school year, we limited class offerings. Our online cohort did NOT have the opportunity to take AP classes in English or Science and were limited overall to AP Statistics, AP Human Geography, AP Calculus (AB), and Honors Multi-Variable Calculus (BC).

COURSE WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Courses from which a student withdraws before the mid-semester are not shown on the transcript; withdrawals after the mid-semester point are indicated as Withdrew Passing (W/P) or Withdrew Failing (W/F). INC indicates final grade to be determined by pending work and is granted only in extreme circumstances, e.g., medical or family circumstances.

SUMMER SCHOOL POLICY

Students can re-take one class with a grade below C- in a CATS Boston—approved summer school or online course in order to meet CATS Boston's promotion standards. The grade earned in the summer course will be added to the transcript, then the CATS Year Grade and the Summer School grade will be calculated into the GPA.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

English	One year of English for every year enrolled in a U.S. high school.
English as a Second Language (ESL)	Non-native English speakers only: one year of ESL for every year at CATS Academy unless you achieve a score of 100 or higher on the TOEFL or a 7.5 on the IELTS exam.
Fine Arts (Music, Fashion, Painting, Drawing, Art History, Theater)	Students entering CATS Academy Grade 9 and 10: two semesters of Fine Arts. Students entering Grade11: one semester of Fine Arts. Students entering Grade 12: no requirement.
Mathematics	Four years of math in the U.S. or another country, acquiring a minimum level of Algebra II by graduation.
Science	Three years of science, which will include two years of lab science (Biology, Chemistry, or Physics) in the U.S. or another country.
Social Science	Three years of social science in the U.S. or another country, including at least one year of U.S. History.
World Languages	Native English speaker only: Level 3 in a World Language by the time a student graduates; optional for ESL students.
