THE ACADEMIC PROGRAM

At CATS Academy, core classes are taught at various levels including College Preparatory, Honors and Advanced Placement. Seniors are limited to four AP classes, and juniors to three AP classes, but there are special circumstances when these limits may be exceeded. Students at CATS also have access to a diverse, wide range of electives.

COURSE WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Courses from which a student withdraws before mid-semester are not shown on the transcript; withdrawals after mid-semester are indicated as Withdrew Passing (W/P) or Withdrew Failing (W/F). Incomplete (INC) indicates final grade is to be determined by pending work and is granted only in extreme circumstances, e.g. medical or family circumstances.

SUMMER SCHOOL POLICY

Students can retake one class with a grade below C- in a CATS Boston-approved summer school or online course to meet CATS Boston's promotion standards. The grade earned in the summer course will be added to the transcript, then the CATS academic year grade and the summer school grade will be calculated into the students GPA.

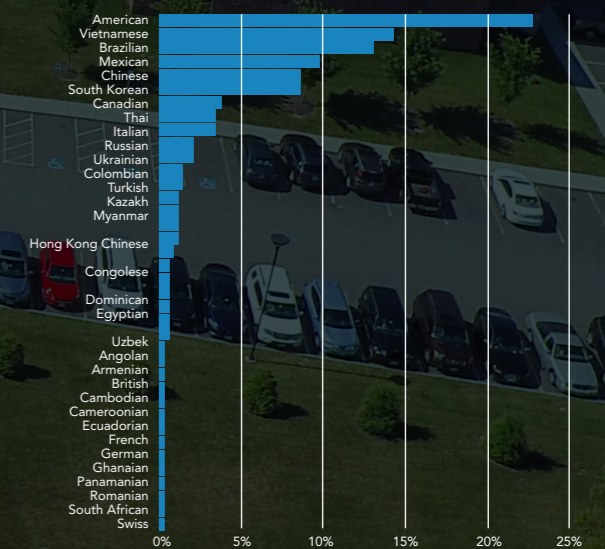


STUDENT BODY

CSVPA ARTS ACADEMY BOSTON

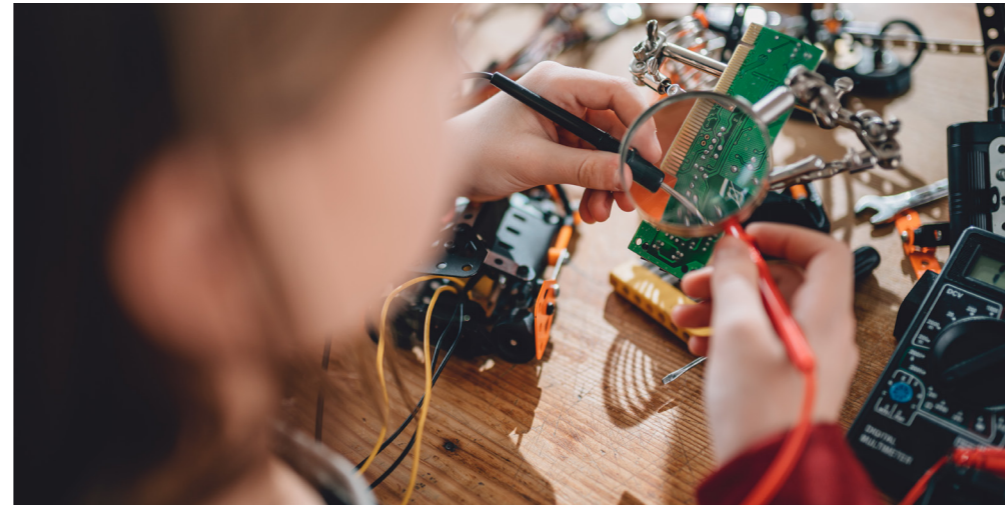
