INCLUDED IN FEES

Tuition fees include ACT/SAT preparation course for students in Grades 11 and 12 (examination fees are not included), materials and books, after school extracurricular and sports program, and lunch for day students.

Accommodation fees include the provision of full-board meals (three per day on weekdays and two per day on weekends), insurance, extra-curriculum activities and sports. Domestic Independent Accommodation does not include health insurance.

*Students will be responsible for standardized exam fees which may include but are not limited to the SAT, ACT, TOEFL or IELTS.

All fees are subject to a \$500 registration fee and a deposit of \$2,500 (refundable at the end of the course). Domestic students are subject to a \$500 registration fee and a \$700 deposit.

ACCOMMODATION DURING VACATIONS

During winter vacation and spring break, the residences are closed – students may return home, stay with approved family/guardians or, if available, a homestay can be arranged for an additional cost. During spring break we also have vacation packages available through Stafford House, ask a representative for further details.

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

We can arrange transport from Boston Logan International Airport to CATS Academy Boston for an additional fee of \$200 (each way). Students under 15 require an unaccompanied minor service and will incur an additional \$200 fee.
